All dogs must be REGISTERED at the Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor. If the Registration or Transfer of Ownership has not been confirmed it must be applied for before the closing date of entries. In case of dispute proof of postage of such applications may be required by The Kennel Club. Puppies under 6 months of age on the first day of the Show cannot be entered for competition, but puppies 4-6 months can enter the Special Puppy Parade for fun/socialisation only this class is NOT FOR COMPETITION. On no account will entries be accepted with out fees. If a dog is in the process of Registration or Transfer at the time entry is made, add the letters NAF or TAF as appropriate after its name. Please put classes in numerical order and USE BLOCK CAPITALS throughout when completing this entry form.

I/We declare that where any alteration has been made to the natural conformation of the dog(s) the relevant permission to show has been granted by the Kennel Club.

I/We further declare that I believe to the best of my knowledge that the dogs are not liable to disqualification under Kennel Club Regulations. I/We also confirm that I/we understand the eligibility of the classes entered.

DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS

Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and Whilst at KC licensed events.

When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route and leave earlier to avoid increased time in Traffic jams.

If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.

The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.

Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.

When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.

Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.

Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated and this could lead to dire results. PLEASE look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR DAMAGE CAUSED.

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulation in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulation.

Right to refuse entries: Exhibitors/Competitors are reminded that the show societies have the right under Kennel CLUB Regulation to refuse any entry.

REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F (Annex B) Apply.

DOG FOULING

Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove immediately any fouling caused by their dog and/or grooming waste at any Kennel Club Show within the licensed venue and within the environs of that event including car and caravan parks and approaches.

ATTRACTING OF EXHIBITS F (1) 17H

THE ATTRACTING OF THE ATTENTION OF EXHIBITS BY ANY METHOD FROM OUTSIDE THE RING IS PROHIBITED IT IS THE DUTY OF THE JUDGE, STEWARD OR SHOW MANAGEMENT NOTICING SUCH ATTENTION TO ASK THAT IT CEASE.
